I. MISCELLANEOUS

<p>A. The Fairfield City School District/Board of Education intends to contract for 36-months (contingent upon E-rate funding on an annual basis) for wide area network, Internet Access (optional), and Interconnected Voice services with the bidder or bidders offering a proposal that is deemed the most acceptable and advantageous to the Fairfield City School District. Fairfield City School District will accept sealed bids to provide specified services beginning July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013.</p>

All questions and responses will be posted to the website for information purposes only.</p>
<p>C. No consideration will be given to any claims based on a lack of knowledge of existing conditions. For this reason, vendor must attend a mandatory site visit/survey to all facilities identified to receive services specified in this bid proposal prior to the vendor submitting a response to the bid. The date and time for site visitation is: December 1, 2009 at 10:00 A.M. at Fairfield City School District Board of Education, 6405 Avenue D, Fairfield, Alabama. Failure to attend will disqualify bidder.</p>
<p>D. Any changes, additions, modifications to the bid request will be posted to the Fairfield City School’s web site Error! Hyperlink reference not valid. It is the responsibility of the vendor to check the website for any changes to the bid request prior to submitting a bid.</p>
<p>E. Sealed bids must be submitted in three (3) printed copies and 1 electronic exact copy (files should be .doc or .pdf format) prior to the bid opening scheduled for January 7, 2010, at 10:00 A.M. (Central Time), at the Fairfield City School District Board Of Education, 6405 Avenue D, Fairfield, Alabama 35064.</p> <p>The envelope must be marked “Bid #1, WAN, Internet Access & Interconnected Voice Services” on the front and “SEALED BID DO NOT OPEN” on the seal. If mailed, mail to Attention: Valerie Holmes at the address listed above.</p> <p>Any late bids will not be opened or considered. No faxed or electronic bids will be accepted.</p> <p>Failure to provide the information requested in this RFP in the requested format is reason for rejection, without consideration.</p>
<p>F. Specifications are not intended to eliminate any reputable manufacturer, brand, or bidder. Reference to manufacturers, brand names, suppliers’ itemization numbers, etc. is intended to set quality standards and does NOT exclude bids from others as long as quality standards are met.</p>
<p>G. If a bid differs in any way from the bid specifications, the bidder must list the differences on the bid proposal form telling exactly where and how the bid deviates from said specifications. If no exceptions are listed on the bid, it will be presumed the bidder proposes to meet the specifications in every respect; and if awarded the contract, performance on this basis will be required.</p>
<p>H. All vendors must use our Bid Response Form for submitting their bid.</p>
<p>I. It is the bidder’s responsibility to comply with all local, state, and federal laws as they apply to this bid.</p>

J.	Fairfield City School District is exempted from all sales and use taxes under the provisions of Title 40, Chapter 23, Section 4 (15), Code of Alabama, 1975.
K.	Bid price is to be all-inclusive and should include all costs necessary for the vendor to connect to Fairfield City School District equipment <i>inside</i> each facility with no further charges made against the Fairfield City School District Board of Education. Vendor pricing should include all taxes, fees, costs necessary for vendor media to enter the building, etc. and any other costs necessary to provision the service.
L.	Contracts over \$10,000 require compliance with Equal Employment Opportunity Regulations, The Clean Air Act, The Clean Water Act, and Environmental Protection Agency Regulations.
M.	If the bid amount is \$10,000.00 or more a certified check or bid bond, payable to the Fairfield City School District Board of Education, in the amount not less than five percent of the amount of the bid but in no event more than \$10,000, must accompany the bidders proposal. Said bond will remain in effect until the contract is completed.
N.	The Fairfield City School District Board of Education is an equal educational opportunity agency and prohibits discrimination in any of its educational programs, including employment, on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, age or any handicapping condition. The Board of Education complies fully with the provisions of Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and the appropriate Department of Education regulations.
O.	The final awarding of this bid will be made by the Fairfield City School District Board of Education based on a recommendation from the Superintendent.
P.	If you choose not to bid, please return the invitation to Fairfield City School District and state the reason. Failure to respond may be cause for your name to be removed from our bid list.
Q.	Fairfield City School District reserves the right to reject any and all bid proposals if deemed necessary.
R.	All vendors must have a valid Service Provider Identification Number (SPIN) with the Schools and Libraries Division of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) AND that SPIN must be approved by SLD to provide Telecommunications and Internet Access services. The Telecommunications status must be maintained for the length of the contract.
S.	Vendor must be classified as a common carrier for telecommunication services and maintain such classification for the length of the contract.
T.	Fairfield City School District will review all proposals for service utilizing guidelines outlined by the Alabama State Bid Law, District purchasing policies, and USAC-SLD E-rate funding.
U.	All vendors submitting a bid are responsible for understanding USAC and FCC E-rate eligibility rules and are required to identify any costs, fees, products, or proposed uses that do not meet the rules of eligibility for E-rate funding and should be filed as ineligible fees/charges.
V.	Vendor must have been in continuous business for a minimum of 3 years and must be the provider, not a reseller of services requested.
W.	Vendor shall furnish to Fairfield City Schools with a Certificate of Insurance showing compliance within the following limitations and is required to maintain this insurance for the duration of the contract. Below is a list of the insurance coverage that must be procured and maintained by the Vendor at his own expense: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personal injury, including death. Limits of \$1,000,000.00 for each person and \$1,000,000.00 for each accident. • Property Damage limits of \$1,000,000.00 for each accident and \$5,000,000.00 for the aggregate
X.	In the event vendor equipment, software, materials, etc. are necessary to provide services, they must be compatible with existing equipment, software, material, etc. The school system is not required to make any purchase of equipment, software, material, etc. to accept the vendors' services. If there are any compatibility issues between the existing equipment, software, etc., and the vendor's services these should be noted in the Bid Response Form Exceptions to Specifications and/or Comments section. Additionally, the vendor shall identify any equipment, software, materials, etc. (and its costs) that must be obtained by Fairfield City Schools before the vendor is able to provide the requested services. Additionally, identify any actions that must be taken by Fairfield City Schools.

<p>Y. Prices shall be good for the length of this contract.</p>
<p>Z. Except as otherwise specifically stated in this RFP, the vendor shall provide and pay for all materials, labor, tools, equipment, transportation, temporary construction of every nature and all other services and facilities of every nature whatsoever, necessary to execute, complete and deliver the work within the specified time. This includes any and all costs necessary for the vendor to connect to Fairfield City School District equipment <i>inside</i> each facility. Licenses necessary for the execution of the work shall be secured and paid for by the vendor.</p>
<p>AA. The Vendor shall protect all buildings, furniture, equipment, personal items, trees, shrubs, lawns and all landscaping on school property from damage. Any damaged property shall be repaired or replaced at The Vendor's expense. Labor shall include all restoration (leveling, sodding) of grounds broken up during the installation of this network.</p>
<p>BB. The Vendor and his representatives shall follow all applicable school district regulations while on Fairfield City School property, including the no smoking, no weapons, and drug free policies. No work shall interfere with school activities or environment unless permission is given by the Principal or person in charge. All Vendor personnel shall be easily identified by the use of prominently displayed identification badges and uniforms or shirts with The Vendor's logo clearly visible.</p>
<p>CC. Fairfield City School District reserves the right to cancel the contract with the vendor for nonperformance at any time during the contract period. Nonperformance includes, but is not limited to; failure to supply good quality service, failure to provide services for the full term of the contract, installation performance, poor billing and customer service services, and failure to maintain status as an authorized representative of services.</p>
<p>DD. At the request of Fairfield City School District The Vendor will be required to invoice the Schools and Library Division (SLD) directly (generate a Service Provider Invoice, FCC Form 474) for the discounted portion of each bill in accordance with SLD regulations. In this case, if requested, the school district will only be invoiced for the undiscounted portion.</p>
<p>EE. Fairfield City School District reserves the right to terminate services if E-rate funding is not approved or is reduced during the specified period of the contract and/or extension periods.</p>
<p>FF. Vendor must be able to provide consolidated billing under a single billing account number and detailed breakdowns of charges to individual location by service type.</p>
<p>GG. This bid and any resulting contract does not restrict Fairfield City Schools from using other Telecommunication and Internet Access services from other vendors.</p>
<p>HH. All requirements specified in this RFP become part of any awarded contract.</p>

II. REQUIREMENTS SPECIFICATIONS**A. Background and Basic Description of the Requirement:**

- a. **Background:** The Fairfield City School District has a wide area network (WAN) connecting all schools and the central office enabling the district to communicate internally and conduct school district business. The current configuration is 6 sites having T-1 (1.5 Mbps) connectivity with Ethernet handoffs at each location. 1.5 Mbps Internet access enters the district at the Board of Education and 10 Mbps is provided by Alabama Supercomputer Authority under the ACCESS program. The Fairfield City School District also has a Nortel Business Communications Manager (BCM) 50 phone system at all locations and a BCM400 at the High School with compatible digital handsets (Nortel Model T7316E) at each location providing telephone services within the school district and to the Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN) outside lines via two Primary Rate Interfaces (PRIs). The internal voice traffic presently traverses dedicated T-1 circuits connected with Nortel SR1004 & SR1001 routers between the served locations within the school district utilizing Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) trunking. The phone system utilizes PRIs for incoming and outgoing calls outside of the school district location. The PRIs are connected at the Board of Education (Qty 1) (services outside calls for the BOE and two schools) and at the High School (Qty 1) (services outside calls for the HS and two schools).
- b. **Basic Description of Requirements:** The proposed configuration to the specifications below must meet requirements and provide Fairfield City School District with a managed leased WAN, managed leased Internet Access with managed firewall, and an interconnected voice system (using the school district owned and operated telephone system).
 - a. **WAN Service Requirements:** The Fairfield City School District requires fully managed, leased WAN service with connectivity between the Board of Education and the five schools listed below (Para II.B.) for the purpose of voice, video (H.323), and data operations. The WAN should connect to the Fairfield City School District local area networks with an Ethernet handoff at each specified location. The vendor must provide a leased WAN with full duplex (not shared) connections and Quality of Service (QoS) to ensure highly reliable voice, video and data operations across the network and to minimize disruption of critical voice services. Pricing is required for the following connectivity levels (dedicated, not shared) between all district locations:
 - i. 10 Mbps
 - ii. 15 Mbps
 - iii. 20 Mbps
 - iv. 50 Mbps
 - v. 100Mbps
 - b. **Internet (with Firewall) Service Requirements:** Option pricing is required for managed leased Internet services with the following Internet bandwidth with security/a firewall with the ability to protect Fairfield City Schools from the service provider's network. Internet services may or may not be elected in the first year of the contract but may be elected in subsequent years. If/when Internet services are elected, the Internet connection should enter the district at the Board of Education and be distributed to all other district locations across the WAN:
 - i. 10 Mbps
 - ii. 15 Mbps
 - iii. 20 Mbps
 - c. **Interconnected/Integrated Voice Service Requirements:** The Fairfield City School District requires the vendor to interconnect/integrate the existing voice system, Business Communications Managers (BCMs), located at each site, with the WAN services, eliminating separate circuits between locations, and utilizing the WAN for voice communications between locations, if possible (this is the preferred solution). Once the voice traffic is on the WAN the WAN service provider will be responsible for managing the voice traffic across the network.

If integrating the existing Fairfield City Schools owned and operated voice system across the proposed

WAN is not possible, the vendor should provide alternative solutions (Note: An integrated approach is required so any proposal should include all costs and activities necessary to provision voice services and connect to the PSTN (outside lines and PRIs will be obtained under separate solicitation but the bidder's solution must include integrating these lines). If alternative solutions are proposed, provide a detailed description of the proposed solution, identify all costs, identify what components of the existing equipment will be utilized in the proposed solution, and provide a description of the proposed service capabilities.

Note: All pricing should be all inclusive and include any and all costs necessary for the vendor to connect to Fairfield City School District equipment *inside* each facility. If Fairfield City School District is required to provide additional equipment, modify any facilities, etc., to accept the handoff from the vendor equipment inside each facility then this must be specified in the bid.

Locations will be added or removed as needed during the term of the contract and any and all contract extensions at the same rates. Fairfield City School District must be able to terminate services and discontinue payments at that time for sites that are removed from the WAN and no longer receiving services due to site closures during the term of the contract and any and all optional extensions.

C. Responsibility for maintaining the equipment and services rests with the vendor. The Vendor will be responsible for installation, configuration, maintenance, support, and replacement, if necessary, of all equipment used to provide the leased services during the specified period of the contract.

D. The backbone network shall be of sufficient capacity to support the voice, video, and data services between the individual sites with sufficient capacity to increase bandwidth, as needed.

E. All communication lines must work with all existing equipment currently in place including but not limited to routers, firewalls, servers, filters, etc. If additional customer equipment is needed to connect at the requested bandwidth, vendor must specify in their response, otherwise vendor will be responsible for providing any required equipment at no additional cost to Fairfield City School District.

F. All pricing must include installation, setup, configuration and maintenance fees. When installation is complete, vendor's connectivity equipment (which may include but not be limited to routers) must be connected to the existing Fairfield City School District network.

G. Vendor must provide estimated pricing for adding additional/new locations (within the boundaries of the Fairfield City), if needed, during the term of the contract. Actual pricing will be requested at the time a new location is identified.

<p>Fairfield City School District must be able to add locations as needed in the event of new schools, new administrative facilities, etc.</p>
<p>H. Fairfield City School District must own the first network device after the demarcation point and only one demarcation/handoff from vendor equipment at each site is permitted (per service). All network designs must adhere to E-rate guidelines for local network independence and on-premise equipment.</p> <p>The On-Premise Priority 1 guideline related to independence: <i>“The Local Network is not Dependent on the Equipment. The internal network at the site must continue to function without connection to the service provider on-premise equipment. Applicants cannot overcome this requirement by installing redundant components because that would be contrary to the requirement to select the most cost-effective service. For instance, on-premise components such as network hubs and network switches that are used to distribute transmissions to multiple locations within a local area network would not meet this requirement because if they were removed then the communication paths among the various network points would be broken.”</i></p>
<p>I. Vendor’s equipment and network must meet industry standards for Quality of Service (QOS) with no additional cost or required upgrades to ensure effective operation and handling of any current and future voice and video (H.323) over IP traffic.</p>
<p>J. Vendor must provide a network diagram and describe the network design including transport speeds between each location and integration of the voice services. A description of the vendor's carrier line and speeds must also be provided.</p>
<p>K. Vendor must provide a minimum contiguous block of 30 IP addresses. Let’s just delete this.</p>
<p>L. Vendor must provide a firewall protection solution with sufficient capacity to protect Fairfield City School District internal network from the vendor’s network and against unauthorized access into the District’s network and other Internet threats while allowing the organization/s users to access the Internet.</p>
<p>M. Vendor must provide a toll free number for technical support Monday-Friday 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. as a minimum.</p>
<p>N. Service Level Agreement (SLA) will include uptime of 99.9%, with issue response time not to exceed four (4) hours. Vendor must make reasonable effort to restore operation within twenty-four (24) hours.</p>
<p>O. The vendor must describe the resources they will use to monitor, manage and repair equipment infrastructure at all locations.</p>
<p>P. Vendor must provide information on any Specializations and/or Certifications of your company and employees to design, implement, and maintain the services and equipment proposed in your solution.</p>
<p>Q. Vendor must provide three (3) references of comparable size and scope with a summary of services provided.</p>
<p>R. System and services must be installed, tested and fully operational to all specified sites at least 48 hours prior to July 1, 2010. If the system is not operational by this time vendor must provide alternative connectivity to all specified locations at their cost. Fairfield City School District reserves the right to terminate the contract and award services to the next qualified vendor if services are not operational as required. Service activation must be transparent and down time, if any, must be at a time determined by Fairfield City School District.</p>
<p>S. The vendor must identify any of the quoted services or portions of services that are ineligible for E-rate funding and provide separate eligible and ineligible pricing.</p>
<p>T. The vendor must provide a transition plan defining and describing the activities and timelines necessary to complete implementation of each of the three requested services (site by site).</p>
<p>U. The vendor must provide a description of how the voice services will be interconnected and integrated with the WAN to enable communications across the network between district locations and communications outside the network through PRI connections to the PSTN (PRIs will be obtained through a separate solicitation but should be integrated with the phone system, if needed, under this solicitation).</p>
<p>V. Upon request, the vendor must provide Item 21 Attachment documentation ready for filing for Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC), Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) FCC Form 471 and assist with providing information needed to respond to SLD application reviewer requests for information.</p>

III. BASIS OF AWARD

In keeping with the guidelines of USAC, this RFP will be awarded to the most cost effective provider who submits a complete and accurate submittal that meets the stated requirements. Prices will be the primary factor, but not necessarily the sole factor, in evaluating the bids. Other factors of consideration may include but are not limited to prior experience, including past performance, personnel qualifications, including technical excellence; management capability, including schedule compliance; environmental objectives; and flexibility of leasing terms and arrangements. Fairfield City School District does not guarantee award of a contract and reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

These factors as well as others may be utilized in weighing the RFP responses as follows:

Fairfield City School District may elect to award all, some or none of the services contained in this request for proposal. Furthermore, while it is preferred that all services be integrated by a single integrating vendor, Fairfield City School District may award more than one contract if it is in the best interest of the district.

IV. REQUIRED CONTENTS OF BID AND ATTACHMENTS

- a. Completed & Signed Bid Response Form (6 pages)
- b. Documentation verifying vendor is a valid E-rate provider with an approved SPIN for both Telecommunication and Internet Access services provided with the bid.
- c. Network diagram and description of the network design
- d. A description of the resources vendor will use to monitor, manage and repair equipment infrastructure at all locations.
- e. Any Specializations and/or Certifications of your company and employees to design, implement, and maintain the network and equipment proposed in your solution.
- f. Transition Plan with Timelines for all Services (WAN, Internet, Interconnected Voice)
- g. Description of how the voice services will be Interconnected and Integrated with the WAN
- h. Three (3) references of comparable size and scope with a summary of services provided
- i. Bid Bond or Certified Check

An entire copy of the bid response and supporting documentation shall be submitted in three (3) paper copies and one exact electronic copy in Microsoft Word or Adobe Acrobat format (.doc or .pdf, respectively).

Failure to provide the required information in the specified manner will be a basis for disqualifying the bid and causing the bid to be thrown out without consideration.
